



Meeting of the German Nagoya Protocol HuB Network (4. GNP HuB Stammtisch)/ Taxon-Omics Nagoya Protocol Workshop

The Nagoya Protocol on Access to Genetic Resources and the Fair and Equitable Sharing of Benefits Arising from their Utilization to the Convention on Biological Diversity is an international agreement which aims at sharing the benefits arising from the utilization of genetic resources in a fair and equitable way. The protocol has been in force since October 2014 and it provides a comprehensive international framework on Access, Benefit-sharing and compliance, or "ABS" for short.

As academic researchers, we may need a permit to access genetic resources and to sign a benefit-sharing agreement with the provider of the resource. Going through this process can be challenging. Therefore, the German Nagoya Protocol HuB (GNP HuB) and Taxon-Omics priority program will be co-hosting a practical hands-on workshop on the Nagoya Protocol (4th GNP HuB Network Meeting) for both the GNP HuB Network and Taxon-Omics priority program members.
